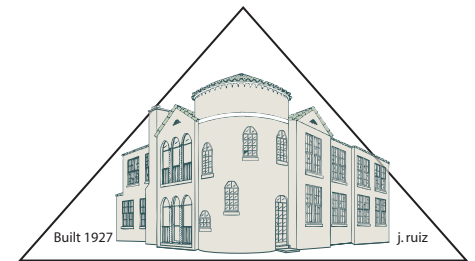
## Triangle Inn Association

## Triangle Inn Association

The Venice community created this not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization in 1994 to promote the historic landmark called the Triangle Inn, which is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Owned by the City of Venice, the Inn was restored with donations of funds, land, and in-kind services by citizens, businesses, and organizations interested in preserving our local heritage.

The Inn, a large triangular structure with an arcade loggia, ornamental detailing, and a tower reminiscent of the Italian Renaissance, is an integral element of the Venice area's cultural charm.

Originally built in 1927 as a rooming house, the Inn today introduces visitors and guests to a collection of local historical information. The first floor contains a city museum and the second floor houses the Venice Archives and Area Historical Collection. In addition, the Inn is a repository of local family trees and historical documents of local organizations. All contribute to the fascinating annals of our community.
